

## Meeting of the Little Falls Swim Club Community Liaison Committee

Monday, May 15, 2017 - 7:00 PM

Cathy Stocker shared renovation updates.

- Regarding the path to the Glen Cove bridge, some plants have been placed in the way of the path. Cathy explained that landscaper will move them to better locations. Many plants will be moved to fill space once temporary bridge is removed. Path will be woodchips since it could not be paved according to guidelines.
- More plants will also be moved to fill in area near Glen Cove bridge and on berm where holes have been left in the greenery. Dead tree near baby pool will be removed.
- Shed inside fence will be replaced and shed will be added at edge of parking lot.
- Where new fence meets old fence near Glen Cove bridge, there will be a gate with an emergency bar. The gate will not be used as an entrance or exit, only as an emergency exit.

We took a tour of the renovated pool.

- There was lots of excitement over the new penguin tiles.

Email contact information of pool neighbors attending meeting was collected to help facilitate future communication.

Pool neighbor expressed concern about gaps in bushes and trees on berm on the Baltimore Ave side of pool property. Also requested that when old shed is removed, larger plants be planted behind it as a screen and that invasives be removed behind shed. These requests were shared with landscaper (Rasevic).

Pool neighbor mentioned locks/handles on gates could be easy to tamper with. Motion sensors and cameras have been installed, along with a monitoring service. These improvements are helping to protect the property.
