



Unattended Children Permission Form

The pool management, staff, and Little Falls Swimming Club Board of Directors are not liable in case of injury and take no responsibility for supervising children. It is recommended that you do not leave your child at the pool unattended.

- Children under 7 years old must be supervised by an adult or teen (age 14 or older) who stays with the child at all times, including during general pool hours, swim and dive team practices, meets, and lessons.
- Children ages 7, 8, and 9 must be supervised by an adult or teen (age 14 or older) who stays with the child at all times, unless this form is completed and on file at the pool.

* At the discretion of the lifeguards, children and guests may be required to pass the Tadpole Swimming Test.

I understand that the job of the pool staff is to monitor water safety in the main pool and they are not responsible for taking care of children. The pool staff does not monitor water safety of children in the baby pool, supervise children in the main pool area or elsewhere on property, attempt to keep children within the pool area, prevent children from leaving the pool property, watch over children who leave the pool, attempt to stop children from playing on the bridge or in the stream, or supervise them in any other way.

Plans have been made for what my child(ren) is to do if the pool closes suddenly due to a thunderstorm, or other unexpected events, such as sanitation or chlorine issues. I understand that unforeseen closings occur frequently and that the staff may lock the pool to leave, even if this means unattended children are left outside the pool area.

To the maximum extent permitted by law, I hereby release the pool management and staff, the Little Falls Swimming Club Board of Directors, and Officers from any and all liability relating to or arising from any injury or damage that may occur to children at any time they are at the pool. The child(ren) listed above have my permission to be at the pool unattended by an adult.
