

## Community Liaison Committee 2014 Updates

March 2014: Letters were hand delivered to every house that borders on or faces onto the Club property on Greenway Drive; Baltimore Avenue, Glen Cove Parkway, Allan Terrace and Little Falls Drive introducing the CLC and inviting the recipients to join and work with the CLC; an initial meeting was held on April 5th at the Club to walk the perimeter and identify any problems or issues that the Club's neighbors may have.

April 2014: Just a quick round up from the April 5th walk-through. Present for the April 5th walk through included: from the board: Jon Slabaugh, Board President; Bob Scribner, Chair of the Buildings and Grounds Committee and myself, Sarah Farnsworth. We were joined by Kevin Guerrero and Mike McNamee. We walked down the alleyway, back along Little Falls Drive, around the tennis courts and then walked along the pool fence. Overgrown vines, dead trees, bushes and ivy choking trees were all noted.

In assessing the grounds next to the stream, a discussion ensued regarding the Club's interest in planting and replacing the dead bushes and trees with native plants to be better neighbors to the Little Falls Stream which bounds the Club on two sides. It will be necessary to present the plan to the Board of Appeals (which will likely seek input from staff at the Department of Parks and Planning) as the Club is presently required to replace trees and bushes with the same type. A plan will be developed, shared with the CLC and then presented to the Board of Appeals for approval. Members of the Little Falls Stream Watershed have offered to assist in the development of such a plan.
