CLC and Buildings and Grounds Committee Consultation with Neighbors and Club Members regarding the current state of Club Grounds

On a blustery cold March 28<sup>th</sup> morning, members of the board of the Little Falls Swim Club, Jon Slabaugh, Cathy Stocker and Sarah Farnsworth were joined by CLC members and club members to conduct an assessment of the grounds in preparation for the handyman pool clean up scheduled for Saturday, April 25.

It was noted that the club has lost over a dozen trees and bushes that had been planted over the past 5 years that will need to be replaced especially along the fence line by the tennis courts. Overhanging tree limbs that could be a cause for concern need to be assessed by a tree company and perhaps trimmed back. The tenacious grape vine weed that smothers bushes along the pool fence line and the fence line/bushes at the end of Court 3 needs to be dealt with aggressively this year. To immediately address the problem of pool members and guests who cut through the properties on Baltimore Avenue bordering the pool to access the pool, the pool board will place PRIVATE PROPERTY signs to remind members and their guests not to use the neighboring property as a shortcut.

The Buildings and Grounds Committee along with the CLC will prioritize the areas of immediate attention and plantings for the yard company that is contracted by the pool so that these can be addressed in the upcoming spring weeks.
