Minutes:

Cynthia Morton, LFSC Community Liaison Committee representative called the meeting to order. Issues presented to those attending included:

<u>Trash trucks</u> – Because of issues moving the trash truck through the alley, the Board has arranged for the trash vendor to pick up trash from across the bridge instead of driving the trucks through the alley.

<u>Parking restrictions</u> – To enforce parking restrictions in areas around the pool such as along Glenn Cove, LFSC will implement a system of parking decals for residents in certain areas where parking is a problem. This will help us identify cars that are parked illegally.

<u>Saturday openings</u> – After request by the Members, the Board agreed to change the opening time of the pool on Saturdays to 10:00am. This change in opening time complies with our Montgomery County approved operating agreement.

Tennis – LFSC is participating in a tennis group that meets at different clubs each Tuesday. So, there will be more activity on Tuesday nights than usual from May through June. We will be careful to make sure that the tennis matches abide by our operating agreement and visiting players will be reminded to park in the parking lot.

Solar Panels will be installed on the roof of the bathhouse.

Cynthia asked for any attending who need to update their names and emails on the master list to do so or to <u>contact her</u>. Email will be used as an additional way to get in touch with you.

At the end of the meeting, the attendees walked the perimeter of the pool boundaries. Ms. Susan Hostetler pointed out vines growing on holly trees. Mr. Henry Hertz noted noise.

Separately, Mr. Tom Snitch noted porcelain berry vines growing on the power lines by the creek.
