Little Falls Swim Club (LFSC) Community Liaison Committee (CLC) August 21, 2023 at 7 PM ET

<u>In attendance:</u> We had 14 participants, of whom 3 were Pool Board members.

Topic 1: One neighbor was concerned that the light on the pool's bath house is very bright and shines into his second-floor window.

- o **Action Item:** We will adjust the angle of the light.
- **Topic 2:** One neighbor was concerned that the kids get noisy around the ping pong tables.
 - Action Item: The pool will keep an eye on this, and if noise level is excessive, have lifeguards ask kids to please lower their noise level.
- **Topic 3:** Several attendees brought up the recent removal of bamboo, which had served as a buffer between the backyards on Baltimore Ave, and the entrance to the pool. The Pool Board did not request the bamboo removal. Instead, a neighbor had requested that the County trim the bamboo, but the County ended up removing the bamboo, because bamboo is an invasive species.
 - Action Item: We will work together to contact the County Arborist/County to find out more information and determine next steps.

Topic 4: One neighbor was concerned about overgrown vines and wear/tear on the fence near the tennis courts.

• **Action Item:** We will inspect the fence line for next steps (overgrowth and fence repair).

Topic 5: One neighbor who was not in attendance wrote the CLC chairs asking about maintaining the alleyway.

• **Action Item:** The alleyway is considered an unmaintained alleyway by the County. There is a shared duty (between the pool and the neighbors) to maintain it.

Topic 6: There is a dead tree in the alleyway.

• Action Item: We will look into it.

Topic 7: The group discussed the Board's idea to seek an extension of the pool season (to open earlier in May, and close later in September). Some neighbors are concerned because, during the pool season, the neighbors already have to deal with the noise from the pool, as well as people who are parking on the street (which is not allowed).

 Action Item: The Board takes very seriously the concerns of the neighbors, especially regarding noise and parking. The Board will continue its outreach to the neighbors.
